Michael C. Lu, MD, MPH is an associate professor of obstetrics & gynecology and public health at UCLA.

Dr. Lu received the 2003 National Maternal and Child Health Epidemiology Young Professional Achievement Award and the 2004 American Public Health Association Maternal and Child Health Section Young Professional Award for his research on health disparities. Dr. Lu has been a leader in the application of the Life Course Perspective in addressing disparities in birth outcomes. The Life Course Perspective suggests that birth outcomes are not only influenced by the care delivered during nine months of pregnancy but from the biological, environmental and social impacts throughout a mother's life.
