

How will ***Top of the Town 2013*** funds used?

Top of the Town funds are used to provide infrastructure to Child Care Resource Center for staff to be able to provide the range of important services for the children of Oklahoma. How will your donation be used to help the Child Care Resource Center? Funds will be used to....

- Provide professional development to child care teachers to include purchasing curricula, paying registration fees for caregivers to attend local or regional conferences, Infant Mental Health Endorsement fees, and incentives for caregivers to attend CCRC sponsored training.
- Early childhood program improvement for the 2013 Tulsa Area United Way's Day of Caring. These projects include classroom toys and materials, playground improvements, paint, brushes, and rollers for indoor and outdoor projects, and other miscellaneous building supplies.
- Developmentally appropriate learning toys and equipment for child care programs, through our onsite Library.
- Books for children's home libraries and early childhood classroom libraries.
- Support the Child and Adult Care Food Program which reimburses family child care home providers for serving nutritious meals and snacks to children.
- New equipment to provide hearing, vision, speech, language, social emotional and developmental screening of children.
- National Accreditation fees for programs seeking accreditation through National Association for the Education of Young Children and National Association for Family Child Care.
- Marketing Babyline/Planline and Resource and Referral services to families.
