Child Development Associate (CDA) Training

The Child Development Associate (CDA) program represents a national and statewide effort to credential qualified caregivers who work with young children. These caregivers may be working in the Head Start programs, family child care homes, child care centers, and preschool programs.

This program of study links theory to practical application and is designed to successfully prepare our adults for the CDA Credential Assessment administered by the Council for Early Childhood Professional Recognition. The program is competency-based and focuses on the theories and techniques for helping children grow physically, intellectual, socially, and emotionally.

Students may enroll in any of the CDA courses, in any order to accommodate individual schedules as well as preference of campus location.

Interested in earning **college credit now?** In addition to preparing our adult students to assess for their CDA credential, we offer a co-enrollment option with Tulsa Community College. Academic credit in the TCC courses may be applied to one of the Certificate of Mastery options and/or an Applied Associate Degree option. This dual enrollment allows you to earn **college credit now?** with no extra course work at the college. Credit is not based on a student being awarded the CDA Credential, but rather on the student's academic achievements.

A limited number of scholarships are available to eligible adult students enrolling in Tulsa Tech's CDA Block courses. Call Regina at 828-2004 or Rebecca at 828-2006 for more information.

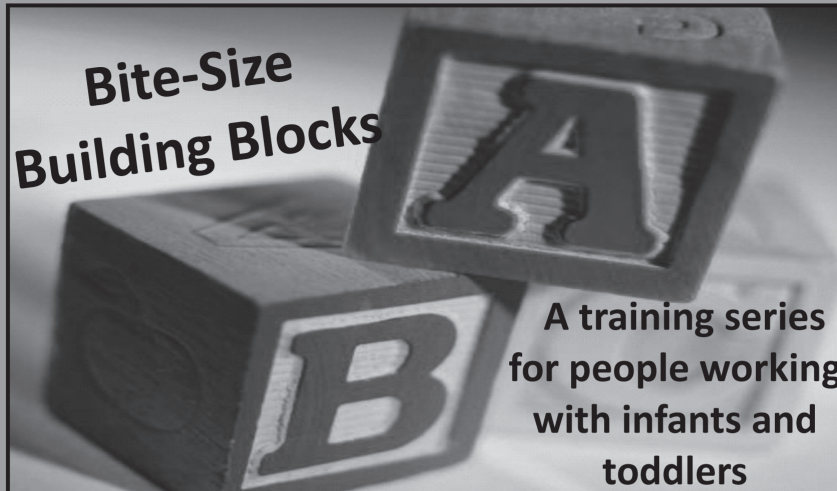
